TRAVEL TO YOUR DESTINATION

All our steelhead packages are built to minimize travel and maximize fishing. Upon booking you should have received our recommended flights that best suit your travel plans. Flights to Terrace and Smithers can be booked with Air Canada. Keep in mind Summer and Fall flights do book early, so if you've booked your trip you should also book your flights at the same time.

AIRPORTS


Most flights to our steelhead locations originate from Vancouver International Airport (YVR) from the domestic terminal. If you are connecting from an international flight the domestic terminal is within easy walking distance. You will need to clear Canadian Customs in Vancouver and pickup your luggage before boarding your domestic flight. Please note some flights to steelhead locations originate in the South Terminal Airport. These flights require a shuttle from YVR.

AIRPORT PICKUP ARRANGEMENT

We offer airport pickup and lodge transfers on most packages during most dates. Please let us know on the Guest Information Form if you require an airport pickup and your arriving flight time and date.

PRE & POST PACKAGE ACCOMMODATIONS

On occasion you may need accommodation arrangements in either Smithers or Terrace before or after your trip. In the case of our Dean River trips you will need pre trip accommodations in Bella Coola, BC. Again, upon booking we will let you know if these are required and can assist or book them for you.



Packing Information

PACKING FOR YOUR TRIP

Due to restricted cargo space, please limit individual luggage to 30 pounds. Soft-sided bags are strongly preferred for both checked and carry-on luggage. Please keep all medication with you when travelling—do not pack these items in your checked luggage.

WHAT TO BRING: ON THE WATER

Staying warm and dry is key to long enjoyable days on the water. Investing in some quality lightweight layers and a heavy duty rain jacket should be a priority before your trip. We advise guests to bring clothing that can be worn in layers underneath the outerwear. Weather conditions can vary significantly from location to location and from month to month with Summer and Fall temperatures in British Columbia that are typically 10-20 C (50-70 F) range., so we advise guests to bring clothing that can be worn in layers underneath the outerwear:

- · Thick warm socks
- · Long underwear and/or fleece pants
- · Long-sleeve shirts, sweater and sweatshirt
- · Fleece and windproof/waterproof jacket
- · Hat, gloves and sunglasses

On rare occasions, some checked luggage may arrive at the lodge later than the guests, so those eager to fish right away should travel with their casual fishing wear. Some other important items you should included while packing for your trip included:

- Toiletries
- Camera
- · Water proof boat bag
- Polarized sun glasses
- · Warm hat, gloves and
- Travel documents including photo identification

WHAT TO BRING: AT THE LODGE

Dress is casual around the lodges and at dinner, so bring whatever you are comfortable wearing.

MEALS & DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

If you have any concerns over food allergies or dietary needs please let us know before your trip as specific needs will be happily accommodated at all lodge locations.

ALCOHOL

Packages vary in terms of alcoholic beverage inclusions. Some offer only beer and wine with dinner, some offer drinks for purchase, others are a byob style.

COMMUNICATION SERVICES

Wireless internet is available free-of-charge at most lodges. Cellular coverage can vary from zero to minimal at most of our steelhead locations while on the water. Don't expect that your carrier will provide service to the area.

GRATUITIES

Gratuities for lodge staff and fishing guides are not included in the package price of your trip. Guests can consult the lodge manager regarding appropriate amounts; gratuities may be left with the guide, manager or at the lodge office.

License Information

WHAT LICENSE(S) DO YOU NEED

Buying your license is a three part process, don't worry it is easy to do and done online in about 10 minutes. First you will need to register, then you will need to ensure you have the following three license:

- · BC Non-Tidal Basic Fishing License
- BC Steelhead Conservation License
- · BC Classified Waters License

If you are a non-resident or non-resident alien we recommend purchasing your Classified Waters License upon arrival at the lodge or upon meeting with your guide. This will ensure you buy the proper daily Classified Waters License for the river(s) you will be fishing.

BUYING YOUR LICENSE

To purchase your license online visit the <u>Freshwater</u> <u>Fishing E-License website here</u>. The license cycle begins on April 1st of each year, so if you are trying to purchase a license for after that date, before April 1st, the system will not work. In this case you must wait until April 1st to purchase a license.
