### Trip Information

#### BOAT LOCATION

Boats are moored on Granville Island, minutes from downtown Vancouver. Please meet at **1814 Mast Tower Road** on Granville Island. This is a small office steps from the boats.

#### WHEN YOU ARRIVE

Depending on your charter start time you will be met at the Bonchovy Charters office by one of our guides or the office manager Nick. If you're early they may be down at the boat getting things ready but will be there for your start time. If you need to get a hold of anyone on the day of fishing please call head guide Jeff Copeland at 604.763.5460.

#### FOOD & DRINKS ONBOARD

All boats have coolers onboard and you are welcome to bring food and drinks, including adult beverages for your day on the water.

#### PARKING

If you are driving there is usually ample parking within a few minute walk of the office and boats. It is a good idea to use the pay parking areas as the free parking is limited to 3 hours.

#### WHAT TO WEAR

We suggest taking a look at the weather prior to your trip and dressing accordingly. Vancouver weather is variable, a windproof jacket and some lightweight layers are key to staying comfortable on the water. There is plenty of space for a carry bag so bringing some extra clothes is not a problem.

#### WHAT TO BRING

It's always nice to bring a few comforts from home, these are not essential but can be good items for your day on the water; sunglasses, camera, small, easy to carry backpack, set of dry clothes or socks. Sunscreen, brimmed cap and bug spray in the Summer. Hand warmers, knitted toque and gloves in the Winter.

#### SEASICKNESS

Rarely do people get seasick on our trips but if you are prone to it then we suggest taking a non-drowsy Graval before disembarking. We are generally fishing protected areas within close proximity to shore.

#### CATCH CARE & PACKAGING

At the end of your trip your fish will be fillet and bagged. If you would like to travel with your fish there is a small seafood shop steps from the boats that can offer boxing, freezing and vacuum packaging services. They can also smoke and can your fish. Fish can be shipped within Canada but not to the US. If you want to take your fish home to the US that is not a problem, sport caught fish can be taken without issue across the border to the United States. ### Important Information

#### FISHING LICENSE

All anglers need a British Columbia Tidal (saltwater) Fishing License to fish with us. Licenses must be purchased online prior to your trip and be printed, signed and with you the day of fishing. If you have a member in your group under 16 years of age their license is free but still needs to be completed through E-License website.

#### SALMON CONSERVATION STAMP

If you want to retain (keep) salmon then you will need to include a Salmon Conservation Stamp. This can be included with the purchase of your license.

#### BUYING YOUR LICENSE

To purchase your license online visit the [Saltwater Fishing E-License website here](#). First register, then purchase your license. The process is very easy and only takes a few minutes.

#### GRATUITIES

Gratuities for fishing guides are not included in the price of your trip. Gratuities are at your discretion and can be left directly with your guide that day if so desired.

#### TRIP CANCELLATIONS

We want your trip with us to be worry free. If your trip needs to be cancelled it can be up to 72 hours in advance with full refund minus an administration fee of \$50. Trips cancelled due to weather conditions are subject to a full refund or credit.
