### Trip Information

#### HOTEL PICKUP

If you've arranged for a hotel pickup please be at the main entrance waiting for your guide with everything you need for the day.

#### AIRPORT PICKUP

If you've arranged for an airport pickup we will meet you inside either the domestic or international terminal depending on your originating city. Keep an eye out for our guide, they will have signage with your name.

#### PICKUP TIME

Please refer to your reservation confirmation for the pickup time. Time factors are based on season, most Winter/Spring trips will have a later start time due to shorter days.

#### RETURNING HOME

At the end of your guided trip with us we'll return you home. Whistler and Vancouver trips are eight (8) hours including travel time, so for a 7.00 AM pickup you can expect to be back at around 3.00 PM.

#### WHAT TO WEAR

Each guest will be fitted with comfortable lightweight wading gear and wading boots. Weather conditions can vary significantly from day to day, or even morning to afternoon (temperatures typically 10-20 C, 50-70 F), so we advise guests to bring clothing that can be worn in layers underneath their outerwear. Stay warm with thick socks, long underwear, fleece pants, long-sleeve shirts, sweaters and sweatshirts. Fleece or windproof jacket and a light rain jacket are also recommended.

#### WHAT TO BRING

It's always nice to bring a few comforts from home, these are not essential but can be good items for your day on the water; sunglasses, camera, small, easy to carry backpack, set of dry clothes or socks. Sunscreen, brimmed cap and bug spray in the Summer. Hand warmers, knitted toque and gloves in the Winter

#### COMMUNICATION SERVICES

Depending on where we are fishing for the day there is usually minimal cellular coverage. While fishing the upper Squamish River or the Birkenhead River there is no cellular coverage.

#### MEALS & DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

Lunches are not included on day trips but are included on package trips. If you are on a day trip it is suggested you bring something to eat, there will be a cooler in the vehicle or we can stop and pickup something at a local coffee shop on the morning drive. If lunch is included in your package and you have any concerns over food allergies or dietary needs please let us know before your trip as specific needs will be happily accommodated.

### Important Information

#### FISHING LICENSE

All anglers need a British Columbia Non-Tidal (freshwater) Fishing License to fish with us. Licenses must be purchased online prior to your trip and be printed, signed and with you the day of fishing. If you do not have your license your trip will not commence.

#### WHAT LICENSE(S) DO YOU NEED

Most anglers will only need a Basic Fishing License. If you are fishing with us during the Spring months and would like to target steelhead you will need to include a Steelhead Conservation License. When purchasing your license please ensure it is dated correctly.

#### BUYING YOUR LICENSE

To purchase your license online visit the [Freshwater Fishing E-License website here](#). The license cycle begins on April 1st of each year, so if you are trying to purchase a license for after that date, before April 1st, the system will not work. In this case you must wait until April 1st to purchase a license.

#### GRATUITIES

Gratuities for fishing guides are not included in the price of your trip. Gratuities are at your discretion and can be left directly with your guide that day if so desired.

#### TRIP CANCELLATIONS

We want your trip with us to be worry free. If your trip needs to be cancelled it can be up to 72 hours in advance with full refund minus an administration fee of \$50. Trips cancelled due to river and/or weather conditions are subject to a full refund or credit.
