
# **ACTIVITY BOOK FOR KIDS**

### True & False Answers

- 1. True. Orcas, or killer whales, are the largest of the dolphins and one of the world's most powerful predators.
- 2. <u>Maybe, but we'll go with false</u>. Being strong swimmers, halibut are able to eat a large variety of fishes, including cod, turbot, and pollock, and some invertebrates, such as octopus, crab and shrimp.
- 3. <u>True.</u> Salmon can migrate more than 3,000 kilometres upstream through freshwater to spawn (Yukon River). That is like driving halfway across Canada.
- 4. <u>True.</u> The ocean sunfish <u>Mola mola</u> and southern sunfish, <u>Mola alexandrini</u>, both recorded at up to 4.6 m (15 ft) in length<sup>[2]</sup> and 2,300 kg (5,100 lb) in weight.
- 5. <u>True.</u> About 5% percent of jellyfish bodies are made of structural proteins, muscles, and nerve cells, while the remaining 95% is water.
- 6. False. There are over 1500 different species of sea star in world's oceans.
- 7. False. They can grow at a rate of 60 cm (2 ft) a day to reach over 45 m (150 ft) long in one growing season.
- 8. <u>True.</u> Adult sea otters typically weigh between 14 and 45 kg, making them the heaviest members of the weasel family, but among the smallest marine mammals.




### True & False Answers

- 1. <u>True.</u> All octopuses are thought to have some venom that comes from bacteria living inside the animals. Most don't have enough poison to harm people. But a bite from a small blue-ringed octopus can paralyze a human adult in minutes.
- 2. False. Tuna can swim at speeds of up to 70 kph (43 mph)
- 3. True. There are over 30,000 species of fish in the world and there are more to be discovered.
- 4. <u>True.</u> The largest sea lion is <u>Steller's</u> sea lion, which can weigh 1,000 kg (2,200 lb) and grow to a length of ten feet.
- 5. <u>False.</u> It was caught in Alaska, not Texas. On May 17, 1985, Les Anderson of <u>Soldotna</u>, AK landed the all-tackle world record chinook salmon, a 97-pound, 4-ounce beast from the <u>Kenai</u> River. The mammoth Chinook was nearly 5 feet long and had an amazing 37.5-inch girth!
- 6. <u>True.</u> Sea Cucumbers are a real thing! They are marine animals with a leathery skin and an elongated body containing a single, branched gonad. Sea cucumbers are found on the sea floor worldwide.
- 7. <u>True.</u> British Columbia is on the Pacific Ocean and the total length of the British Columbia Coast is over 25,725 kilometres (15,985 mi), making up about 10% of the Canadian coastline!
- 8. <u>False!</u> You can't have a humpback whale in your bathtub you silly! Humpback whales are enormous creatures about the size of a school bus.





### STURGEON FACTS

Sturgeon live in large, freshwater lakes and rivers but some species also travel to the ocean and return to rivers and lakes to breed.

Their average lifespan is 50 to 60 years, and their first spawn does not occur until they are around 15 to 20 years old.

Sturgeon can be found in British Columbia's Fraser River.

All sturgeon in British Columbia have to be released when caught. Don't take them out of the water and make sure they are handled with care. Even though they are big you have to be extra gentle with them.
